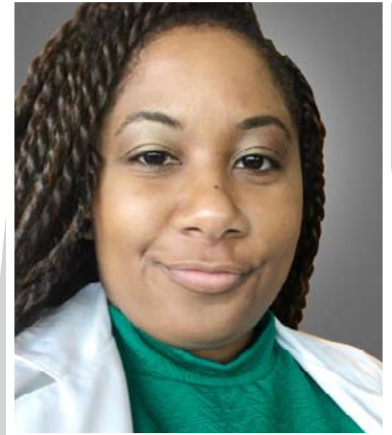

Prior she served as a panelist with Family Community Church during their Unity Symposium, which aimed to promote ideas and solutions for all Americans to live in Unity through Humility and Dignity. She currently teaches a monthly virtual wellness class as a part of her church's ministry, and she is writing her first book.

Karen is the mother of three adult children who all serve the community in their respective vocations. One of her favorite quotes is, "Look for something positive in each day, even if some days, you have to look a little harder."



Shantay R. Davies-Balch, M.B.A.

Director, African American Coalition COVID-19 Equity Project

Shantay R. Davies-Balch is a native of Fresno, California, where she has dedicated her career to improving health outcomes for all women and babies, with an emphasis on Black women and babies who tend to have the worst health outcomes. Shantay is a certified lactation educator, doula, and certified newborn care specialist, with an expertise in premature birth, infant and maternal mortality, and breastfeeding. Shantay is President and CEO of BLACKWellness a Prosperity Center, the first CBO in Fresno County established to address the specific Black Maternal Child Health Crisis. She is the Primary Community Investigator for a fatherhood/doula research pilot in partnership with UCSF and a member of the Black Maternal Infant Health Statewide Advisory to develop the first comprehensive statewide report on the status of Black women and babies in 30 years. Shantay is also an active member of Black Women Organized for Political Action (BWOPA). Lastly, Shantay serves on the GO Fresno Schools Leadership Council, she is a First 5 Fresno County appointed Commissioner, and Foster Care Standards and Oversight Committee Board Member.

Currently, one of Shantay's most formidable accomplishments is leading the COVID-19 response in the African-American community across Fresno county.

Shantay graduated Summa Cum Laude from Fresno Pacific University with a degree in Healthcare Administration. She also received her Master's in Business Administration from Johns Hopkins University, Carey Business School, with a specialty in Healthcare Management, and in 2018, U.S. Senator Kamala Harris formally recognized Shantay for her leadership in addressing Black Maternal Health by presenting her with a 40 Under 40 award.
